The 2016 season will mark the 31st season o Varsity Soccer at Carroll! In that time the Carroll H.S. Boys' Soccer program has become one of the premiere programs in the State, Ranked in the Indiana Soccer Coache Association Top 20 for the last 18 seasons Carroll has proven to be competitive across Indiana.

The 2015 Chargers finished their season with a record of 13-5-2 and were ranked #15 in th Final ISCA Poll.

Carroll began playing Varsity Boys' Soccer ir 1987. In the years following, the Chargers have posted a record of 390-135-43 (.724). Twenty seven consecutive winning seasons and an average of 13.0 wins each season have become the foundation of the Carroll tradition.

When the I.H.S.A.A. began to sanction Soccer in 1994 Carroll advanced to the first "Final Four" and returned again in 2003. In the nineteen years of state sanctioned Socce Carroll has claimed 12 Sectionals, 7 Regionals, and 2 Semi-States. Those totals place Carroll among the top in each category in IHSAA history!

Carroll players have claimed numerous local state, and national awards including NSCAA All-American Michael Knitter and I.H.S.A.A. Mental Attitude Award winner Dan Fox. Tim Wylie ('08) continued a tradition of Chargers moving on to the next level as a member of the 2012 Indiana University National Championship team!

Tryouts

Tryouts begin on Monday August 1 on the Soccer Practice Field at 8:00 AM. All candidates are expected to be present Before the tryouts each candidate is expected to have a completed physical of the approved IHSAA form on file in the Athletic Office no later than July 15. Physicals must be dated after April 1, 2016 for the 2016 season and use the proper 2016-17 IHSAA form. The first day of tryouts will include fitness and skills tests to assess the off-season preparation of candidates.

Over those first days of tryouts the coaching staff will be evaluating candidates during two-a-day sessions in preparation for selecting the final roster.

The Season

Carroll will again play one of the more demanding schedules in the State! The schedule includes a total of 17 games including 8 with teams ranked in the Fina 2015 ISCA Poll. Season highlights include the 11th Annual Carroll Classic featuring one of the top fields in Northeas Indiana. Other highlights are games with traditional local & State powers Canterbury, Warsaw, Goshen, Homestead, Blackhawk Christian, Penn, and West Noble. All this is in preparation to begin State Tournament play in October as the Chargers will be seeking their 13th Sectional title!
