SAT Test Day Checklist What to bring – and not bring to the SAT

Must bring:

- ✓ Your admission ticket. Sign in to My SAT and click "Print Admission Ticket"
- ✓ Two No. 2 pencils and a soft eraser
- ✓ Photo identification. You will <u>not</u> be able to take the SAT without a valid photo ID (school ID, driver's license, passport). You must be clearly recognizable in the photo.
- ✓ An acceptable calculator (graphing or scientific). Laptops, pocket organizers, cell phone calculators, calculators with a QWERTY keyboard, etc. are not allowed.

Nice to have:

- ✓ A watch without an audible alarm
- ✓ Extra batteries and backup equipment
- ✓ A drink and/or snacks for your break

DO NOT BRING:

- ✓ Cell phones or smart phones, including iPhones, BlackBerrys, or Android devices
- √ iPods or other MP3 players
- ✓ iPads or other tablets
- ✓ Laptops, notebooks, PDAs or any other personal computing devices
- ✓ Pagers or other texting devices
- ✓ Separate timers of any type
- ✓ Cameras or other photographic equipment
- ✓ Any device capable of recording audio, photo or video content, or capable of viewing or playing back such content
