

## Junior Year Academic "To-Do" Checklist

## **FALL**

	as the necessary classes)
	Make an electronic file to manage your college search, testing, and application data
	Begin exploring colleges – online ( <u>www.triptocollege.com</u> , <u>www.campustours.com</u> , or <u>https://indiana.kuder.com</u> ), <u>College Handbook</u> resources in guidance office, sign up for CHS college visits when available
school	Take a variety of campus visits (local, large, small, public, and private) if available during vacation days. Take note of each school's admission requirements
	Take the PSAT or ASVAB offered at CHS in the fall
	Attend CHS Financial Aid night
	Prepare to take the SAT by reviewing PSAT results, online resources ( <u>www.collegeboard.com</u> , <u>www.actstudent.org</u> ), taking additional practice tests, or prep course
	Register for the SAT and/or ACT at least once junior year and again before senior year begins
	WINTER  Make sure to pass first semester REQUIRED courses for graduation. See counselor ASAP if
	you need to make up a credit during $2^{nd}$ semester.
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## **SPRING** Continue exploring career choices and possible majors (www.bridges.com, https://indiana.kuder.com or www.learnmoreindiana.com) Look into junior-eligible scholarships Attend CHS College/Career Fair Sign up for summer school or online courses (need to see counselor about this first) if needed for credits **SUMMER** Take advantage of the summer to job shadow, volunteer, and resume build Report any online credits earned over the summer to your counselor ASAP. Make sure my class schedule is correct PRIOR to registration. Take campus tours and, at the colleges I'm serious about, make appointments to have interviews with admissions counselors. Narrow selection to about 6-8 colleges Update my resume – a record of accomplishments, activities, awards, and work experiences since you started high school. Check application dates as large universities may have early dates
