This scholarship is intended for students who are planning to attend a two-year or four-year college/university or vocational/technical school after graduating from Carroll High School.

Requirements

1. Applicants must be a member of the Carroll High School graduating class.
2. Applicants must have attended Eel River Elementary School for two years.
3. Applicants must complete the application form and write a one-page, single spaced essay (topic is listed on the application form).
4. Applicants must have applied to or have been accepted at a two-year or four-year college/university or vocational/technical school.
5. The application form and essay must be submitted to the Senior Guidance Counselor no later than **April 22, 2020**.

Selection

All application forms and essays will be reviewed by the Eel River Scholarship Committee. The recipient will be selected on a weighted basis in the areas of community involvement/volunteer activities, extracurricular participation/part-time employment, and essay.

Presentation

One graduating senior will receive a \$500.00 scholarship at the Carroll High School Honors Night.
