\*\*There is no charge for summer PE *UNLESS* a student must purchase a PE uniform. Students may wear their Carroll Middle/Maple Creek Middle School PE uniform if the uniform is in good condition. If a student needs to buy a uniform, the cost is \$16.25.

**NOTE:** A maximum of 250 students will be enrolled in each summer session. Students will be enrolled in summer school PE on a first-come, first-serve basis. After the maximum number is reached, the summer session will be closed. A letter will be sent via mail in May with specific information regarding Summer PE.

Students must be in attendance. Students may miss one day of Summer School. Four (4) tardies of up to 15 minutes will result in one day missed. Anything beyond one day missed (and 3 additional tardies) results in dismissal from Summer School. Medical and/or parent notes excusing students from participation are not accepted.

- There will be two fifteen-minute breaks.
- All of the rules from the school year apply.
- Any disciplinary problem may result in dismissal from Summer School.
- The teacher has the authority to dismiss a student from Summer School.

**PE SWIMMING REQUIREMENT:** During summer PE, students participate in swimming activities at the NACS natatorium. Any student with long hair is required to wear a swim cap while in the pool. Female students must wear a one-piece swimsuit.

Swimming is a required component of Carroll High School's PE curriculum during the academic school year; thus, swimming activities are incorporated into summer school. As noted above, Indiana statute indicates that students enrolled in summer coursework must be in attendance and participating in order to earn high school credit. **Students will not be excused from the swimming portion of the class.**
