

# EDUCATOR SCHOLARSHIP

## **NORTHWEST ALLEN COUNTY TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION**

The Northwest Allen County Teachers' Association Educator Scholarship has been established to recognize two outstanding students of NACS who are pursuing a degree in education.

The Educator Scholarship is award based on academic achievement and leadership as expressed through co-curricular activities and community involvement. Scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded to two graduating seniors pursuing careers in education. The NACTA Educator Scholarship will be announced and presented during the Carroll High School Honors Program in May.

### **Eligibility and Selection Criteria**

- Applicants must be graduates of the class of the current year.
- Applicants must be planning on entering as a freshman at a fully-accredited postsecondary institution upon graduation.
- The Scholarship Committee will use the following criteria for selection:
  - Academic achievement
  - Leadership ability as expressed through co-curricular activities and community involvement
  - Essay

### **Application Process**

1. Complete the NACS Association scholarship application form.
2. Attach an official seven-semester high school transcript.
3. Include a copy of the letter of acceptance (into an education program) from the college or university you will be attending.
4. Include a typewritten essay of 500 words or fewer outlining your future goals in education, what motivated you to those goals, and how you plan to achieve those goals. Begin your essay by articulating your specific teaching goal ("I want to teach Advanced Placement Calculus in an Indiana school district."), then explain what led you to choose education, and finally include what you have done, are currently doing, and will do in preparation for a career in teaching.
