

Carroll High School Hope Scholarship

The 2020 Award Given in Memory of Emily Jovevski

This is a new scholarship opportunity given by the Northwest Allen Teachers' Association to a student who is pursuing a career dedicated to serving others (this could be health care, ministry, counseling, etc.), OR to a student who has overcome great physical adversity to enroll in a collegiate-level program. The scholarship is a one-time gift of \$2,000 given directly to the recipient.

To apply, students must complete the application provided and submit it with a letter of acceptance from a collegiate-level program, a copy of their high school transcripts, and a personal essay explaining why they qualify to apply for the Carroll High School Hope Scholarship.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be graduates of the class of the current year.
- Applicants must be entering as a freshman at a fully-accredited postsecondary institution upon graduation.

Application Process:

- Complete the NACS Association scholarship application form.
- Attach an official seven-semester high school transcript.
- Include a copy of the letter of acceptance (into an education program) from the college or university you will be attending.
- Include a typewritten essay of 500 words.

Applications are due no later than April 8, 2020. Submit all necessary materials to the guidance office in an envelope marked: Carroll High School Hope Scholarship; ATTN: Ms. Melinda Hopkins.

The recipient of the scholarship will be notified during the senior awards night in May.
